



Boarding Services

Dutch Fork Animal Hospital provides boarding services for your beloved pets. We have separate boarding areas for dogs and cats, and even offer luxury runs for the most pampered members of your family. We individually walk all dogs at least three times a day in a fenced grassy area. Our kennel yards are furnished with a synthetic grass, "Ultimate K9 Turf", which prevents muddy paws and keeps your pups comfortable outside. Using synthetic grass not only keeps the yard 17 degrees cooler, it is also anti-microbial. All pets receive Science Diet maintenance and prescription food at no additional charge, but if your pet requires special food, feel free to bring it. Our staff will gladly administer any medications your pet requires, and we do ask you bring your own medications. If any health problems arise, our veterinarians are available to take care of your pet.

In order to be a boarding patient, please make sure your pet is up to date on all of their vaccines. This keeps all of the pets staying with us safe and healthy. For dogs, they are required to be up to date on: DHLPP, Rabies, Bordetella (kennel cough) and Canine Influenza Virus (CIV). We require Bordetella to be given every 6 months. Cats are required to have a Feline Leukemia/FIV test and must be current on their FVRCP, FELV (for indoor/outdoor cats), and Rabies. If your pet is in need of these vaccines, we will gladly update them during their stay at our kennels.

Canine Boarding Options

For all of the special dogs in your life, we have luxury boarding areas available. These are in a quieter section of the hospital and feature spacious rooms with cable TV, raised feeders, beds, and a mural painted by a local artist to make your pet feel like they are traveling the world! Each kennel features a different travel theme. Fluffy can sleep at the base of the Swiss Alps! Sweetie can relax with a view of the Eiffel Tower! Jake can experience St. Basil's Cathedral in Moscow, Russia from his comfortable cot!

Our regular boarding section features several sized runs to choose from. Our kennel staff is highly trained and they are constantly with our boarders, so we can determine what size is best suited to your pet. We have cots and a lot of beds and blankets for your dog, so you do not need to worry about bringing any bedding for your pet. We also want to ensure that none of your items are lost or damaged. If you have more than one dog, we have large family runs so your pets can stay together.

For an additional fee, we will gladly bathe your dog before departure. The bath includes an ear cleaning, anal gland expression, shampoo, blow dry, brush out, and nail trim.

Feline Boarding Options

All of our feline friends have a separate boarding section from the dogs. We have cat condos available for families who have more than one cat. In addition, we also offer a wonderful suite for the cats with perches, a window view, and all of those little toys cats love.
